## Greetings, Fellow Veterans of the Geodetic Survey Squadron and Geodetic Survey Group!

And Happy Heat Wave!

Sorry for the delay. I had hoped to send this out on the Fourth of July, but my computer has been down and out for two weeks and required major surgery! Just got it back today. After a lot of frustrating fits and starts, I finally have it back under my control!

We are only about two-and-a-half weeks from our forthcoming reunion in Cheyenne, and I am reluctant to say it, but so far, attendance looks like it will be lower than usual! In the past, we have had an average of 85-to-100 attendees for each event, so, if you are coming and have not yet committed, the clock is ticking!

Bonnie and I plan to drive out to Cheyenne from Virginia on or about 28 July and expect it to take four days to get there. So, *if you are coming to the reunion, you need to select the events you plan to attend and <u>send me your meal and event reservations and payment ASAP!!!</u>* 

Likewise, if you are staying at the reunion hotel, make your reservations with the hotel now!

Please reserve your room and meals well in advance of the reunion (recommending no later than 25 July) so that the hotel has an accurate count of how many attendees to expect and how many meals to prepare. Pay ME for meals, not the hotel! Pay by check only! I will settle with the hotel at the end of the reunion. If you try to pay at the door during the reunion, you may be out of luck or the hotel may add a hefty surcharge!

Here's a repeat summary of the reunion information:

- Red Lion has blocked rooms for the reunion at the special rate of \$82 per night plus tax. Remember to say you are with the Geodetic Survey reunion or "event #1006."
- · Agenda (so far):
  - o Friday August 3<sup>rd</sup>: **Meet and Greet** from 6:00 pm-11:00 pm (**cash bar**), free snacks provided by the Hotel. (Room location to be announced in the lobby.)
  - o Saturday August 4<sup>th</sup>: **Two-Entrée Buffet lunch** from 11:00 am until 2:00 pm **\$26 per person**, including tax and tip. (Room location to be announced in the lobby.) Recognition and awards to be presented. Afternoon tours on your own.
  - o Saturday Evening Aug 4<sup>th</sup>: **Wine and Cheese Social \$5 per person**, the Rawhide Room hospitality suite. (Time to be announced later, but will likely be after 6 pm.) We also request that those attending bring a bottle of wine or other favorite beverage. Cheese, crackers and other snacks will be provided.

#### GSS/GSG Commemorative Coins and Pendants:

The coins and pendants are selling briskly. The artwork for the final design of our commemorative coins and pendants is available for you to see on our GSS/GSG website, but the actual items are much more impressive than the images!

Recall that the Squadron/Group had five different designations throughout its history. We commissioned a coin for the original name---1381<sup>st</sup> Geodetic Survey Squadron (Missile) – 1959-64---for the 2015 reunion, and they all sold out.

For this reunion, we are offering the other four designations.

- Coin A: 1381st Geodetic Survey Squadron (1964-68) (USAF emblem on the back)
- Coin B: 1<sup>st</sup> Geodetic Survey Squadron (1968-72) (USAF emblem on the back)
- Coin C: Geodetic Survey Squadron (1972-89) (DoD emblem on the back)
- Coin D: Geodetic Survey Group (1989-92) (DoD emblem on the back)

Please review the four designs at our website and make your selection: coin A, B, C, or D. Some may want all four designs, and others, only the design corresponding to their time in the unit.

For this initial run, we have ordered only 45 of each coin design and five more of each for the pendant or key fob design. This latter design includes a fused bezel and loop to convert the coin to a neck pendant, key fob or other hanging decoration.

The cost for each coin is \$7.00 plus shipping and handling

The cost for each pendant is \$9.00 plus shipping and handling

In general, you should expect to receive your items roughly one business week from the time you mail it to me. Coins will be enclosed in sealed plastic bags and mailed in bubble-wrap padded envelopes.

NOTE: The coins will <u>NOT</u> be available for sale or pick-up during the reunion. My plan is to distribute <u>all</u> ordered coins by <u>mail order only until sold out, hopefully BEFORE the reunion.</u>

However, you may continue to order coins AFTER the reunion, until they are sold out! I will resume filling orders after I get back home from the reunion. If there is sufficient demand after they sell out, I can reorder as many more of each coin or pendant as needed, <u>including the original sold-out design</u> offered in 2015! However, reorders will have to wait until after I return home from the reunion and post-reunion road trip, probably late August or early September.

## Final Notes:

I look forward to meeting as many of you as possible in Cheyenne soon!

If you plan to attend the reunion and if you plan to order coins or pendants, I urge you to do so now! Bonnie and I expect to leave for Cheyenne on or about 28 July. When the reunion is over, we plan to hit the road again, this time to the northwest via the Grand Tetons, Yellowstone, western Montana, Idaho, Washington state, Oregon and then visit our kids and grandkids in the San Francisco Bay Area before driving back home to Virginia. If you don't make your reunion event reservations in the few days or order your coins now, I may not be home to receive your order! You may be out of luck for the reunion and have to wait for your coins until I get back home! Don't delay; order today!
